1. Circumstances Surrounding Death

On November 25, 2015, two month old, [REDACTED] was found unresponsive in her home by her mother.

The mother stated [REDACTED] was placed in the mother's bed to sleep around 1:00 AM on November 25, 2015. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The mother woke at 3:30 AM, to use the bathroom and [REDACTED] was fine at that time. The mother woke the next time around 5:00 AM, and checked on [REDACTED] and the child was not breathing. The mother ran with [REDACTED] to the roommate's bedroom and they attempted CPR and then called 911. Emergency Medical Services (EMS) responded to the 911 call and resuscitation efforts were attempted. [REDACTED] was immediately transported to the hospital where she was pronounced deceased.

The only other adult in the home at the time of the incident was the mother's roommate, who states she was asleep until the mother came into her room yelling that [REDACTED] was not breathing.

The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) responded to the scene and conducted the criminal investigation. They interviewed the mother regarding the incident and noted that she provided different stories regarding the sleeping arrangements and circumstances surrounding [REDACTED] death over the course of their interviews. The JSO investigation remains open at this time and while no charges have been filed against the mother, JSO and the State Attorney's Office continue to review the findings of their investigation.

The Medical Examiner completed an autopsy on November 25, 2015. The manner and cause of death could not be determined.

The Duval County Child Protection Team reviewed the medical files and the Medical Director concluded, "Undetermined for child abuse." The review found the case highly concerning for abuse [REDACTED]


Based on the information obtained during the course of the investigation, the Department of Children and Families, Duval County Child Protective Investigations closed the abuse report on June 28, 2016, with no indicators on the maltreatment of death due to inadequate supervision. The maltreatment of threatened harm was verified [REDACTED]. While the history is extremely concerning, the investigation found no evidence that the death of [REDACTED] was due to abuse or neglect.
