### **Task Force Goals**

#### Prevention

- 1. Review local <u>data</u>, <u>policy</u>, <u>and procedures</u> to analyze the scope of the issue in the local system.
- 2. <u>Improve placement decisions</u> for children in foster care who are high risk due to sexual behaviors.
- 3. Help develop and institute <u>standardized Safety Plans</u> that can be used in a variety of settings (e.g., schools, foster care, therapeutic group homes and foster care, etc.) related to children with sexual behavior problems and/or who are at high risk for acting out sexually.

# Task Force Goals (Cont.)

#### Prevention

- 4. Provide <u>community trainings</u> related to child-on-child sexual abuse and children with sexual behavior problems.
- 5. Develop <u>core trainings</u> related to the prevention and intervention of child-on-child sexual abuse cases for <u>public schools</u>.

# Task Force Goals (cont.)


#### Advocacy

- 6. Collaborate with the state to develop and institute <u>certification</u> <u>requirements</u> for DCF, foster care staff, mental health professionals and others who work directly with children with severe sexual abuse trauma and/or sexual behavior problems.
- 7. Research and provide recommendations regarding <u>laws and policy</u> <u>issues</u> that affect children with sexual behavioral problems and/or who have been charged with sexual offenses.
- 8. Establish a <u>state-wide Child-on-Child Sexual Abuse Prevention Task</u>
  <u>Force</u> as well as Task Forces at the local/community levels.
