A Child Care Facility may claim Religious Exemption from Licensure annually *if*:

- It is an integral part of a church or parochial school -- conducting regularly scheduled classes, courses of study or educational programs.
- It is accredited by, or by a member of, an organization that publishes and requires compliance with its standards for health, safety and sanitation.
- It meets background screening requirements in ss. 402.305 and 402.3055, Florida Statutes. Failure to comply with these screening requirements will result in loss of the facility's exemption from licensure.

Religious Exempt Child Care Facilities must complete an annual online statement attesting to the fact that the program remains eligible for exemption pursuant to s. 402.316, F.S., and that current background screening requirements are being met and upheld.
