SUBJECT:

Go-Live for FSFN Enhancements - Modifications to Person Provider Inquiry

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this memorandum is to announce the approval of the Florida Safe Families Network (FSFN) enhancements scheduled to be implemented on August 17, 2018. The FSFN system will be unavailable Friday, August 17, 2018 from 10:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. to implement this new functionality.

**BACKGROUND:** New Unified Home Study workflow enhancements were identified to ease the workload for child welfare workers. The enhanced FSFN Person Provider Inquiry will now allow a Background Check to be requested before initiating a Unified Home Study and will not require a Unified Home Study to be completed when there are documented automatic criminal disqualifiers. It also allows for child welfare workers to associate cases and children with the Person Provider Inquiry Background Check.

**TRAINING INFORMATION:** The <u>Person Provider Streamlined Workflow Job Aid</u> and the <u>FSFN Web-based Tutorial</u> for Person Provider Inquiry and Completing Background Checks have been updated to align with the updated FSFN functionality.
