


PARENTS ... It's Your Call!

If your child went to Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) and will be attending kindergarten in a non-public school, you are responsible for having your child screened during the first 30 days of kindergarten.

Section 1002.69(4), Florida Statutes



Be sure to tell your child's kindergarten teacher that your child attended VPK.

District public schools will coordinate the screening with your child's school.

Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener (FLKRS) is a brief screening to determine your child's progress in attaining Florida's Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) Education Program Standards.

Screening will be administered in the first 30 days of kindergarten.

Your child's kindergarten teacher will review the results of the screening with you.

Results from the screening will be used to determine the VPK Provider Readiness Rate.
