Did you know...

Florida is the second leading state in pediatric hot car deaths.*
Follow these tips and reminders to help prevent hot car deaths:



Senate Bill 252 requires an alarm system to be installed in each vehicle used for transportation.



Maintain a log with child's name, date and time of departure, and initials of the child care personnel who conducts second visual and physical sweep.



Conduct physical and visual sweeps.
