## What is Florida NYTD?

Florida NYTD, is a survey comprised of questions from the Federal National Youth In Transition Database, the Florida IL Checklist, Florida Statutes and DCF Policy as well as questions by youth, young adults and other stakeholders in the child welfare system.


The survey can be completed on-line, on paper or by telephone.

### Who takes the Florida NYTD Survey?

Young people ages 18-22, who turned 18 in licensed foster care. Many of the young people completing the survey are receiving services through Florida's Extended Foster Care program and/or Road to Independence Program.

When is the Florida NYTD Survey?

This year the Florida NYTD survey was open from April 15th—May 31st .
