

SCHOOL MENTAL HEALTH GALINCENTIVE LANGUAGE



- 1. Current and new funding maybe allocated by school districts to use a similar model like the Pasco/Hillsborough/Broward School Mental Health that contract with organizations and provide accountability back to the school district consistent with the School Mental Health. This would ensure students and their families have access to behavioral health services 24/7 year-round, as needed.
- 2. Current and new funds maybe allocated by school districts for School Mental Health programs that offer similar access to mental and behavioral health services consistent with the School Mental Language. The contract with organizations will provide accountability back to the school district. This would ensure students and their families have access to behavioral health services 24/7 year-round, as needed.

- 3. School districts may utilize current and new funding allocation to implement a hybrid model of the Pasco/Hillsborough/Broward School Mental Health and current school mental health programs.
- 4. The implementation of these types of models would allow for a more efficient use of funds as it would ensure all potential funding streams are utilized to support the students and their families. This is due to the blended and braided funding between the MEs, Managed Care Plans, Private Insurance, etc.. This collaboration maximizes and ensures services are coordinated at the correct level of care via care coordination.
- 5. The care coordination of services between the school districts and MEs ensure access and supports to behavioral health services year-round.
