

Need to complete your DCF Child Care Mandatory Training, but not sure where to start?

While Child Care Mandatory Training (40 hours) can be taken in any order, DCF recommends the following:

Complete Part I (30 HOURS) TRAINING IN THIS ORDER:

1. Child Care Facility Rules and Regulations (RNRF)
2. Identifying and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect (CAAN)
3. Health, Safety, and Nutrition (HSAN)
4. Child Growth and Development (CGDR)
5. Behavioral Observation and Screening (BOSR)

Complete Part II AFTER PART I COURSES HAVE BEEN COMPLETED, YOU SHOULD START PART II (10 HOURS) TRAINING:

If you select the developmentally appropriate practices option, we recommend you complete the Understanding Developmentally Appropriate Practices (UDAP) course before taking one of the age specific courses (ITPR, PSPR, or SAPR).

- Understanding Developmentally Appropriate Practices (UDAP)

AND one (1) of the following:

- o Infant and Toddler Appropriate Practices (ITPR)
- o Preschool Appropriate Practices (PSPR)
- o School-Age Appropriate Practices (SAPR)

OR

- Special Needs Appropriate Practices (SNP)

Please note: All of the 40-hour required training **must be completed one year** from the date the training began. Child care personnel must pass **competency exams** for the 40 hours of training to demonstrate their competency or receive an **educational exemption**.
