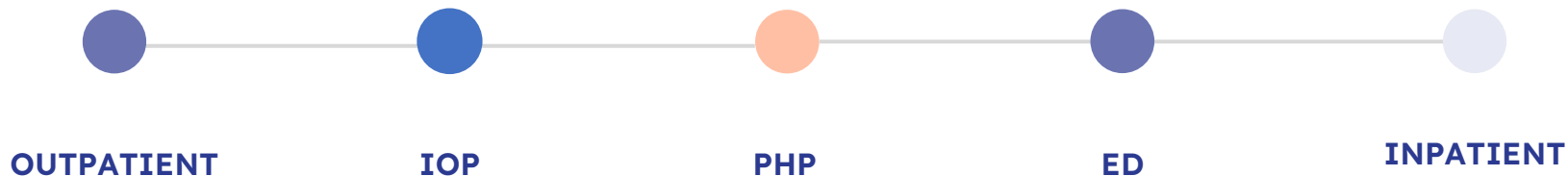

Virtual Care Reduces Barriers to Treatment

“We have such a wide spectrum of teens right now - from millionaire’s children to kids who just moved out of a house where roaches literally were falling from the ceiling onto her bed - all of whom are talking and connecting with one another on the level playing field of mediocre internet reception, bedroom posters and poor lighting. Transportation – increasingly diverse patient population with transportation barriers removed.

Family engagement – easier for families to participate in family therapy and integrate it with work and other caring responsibilities.



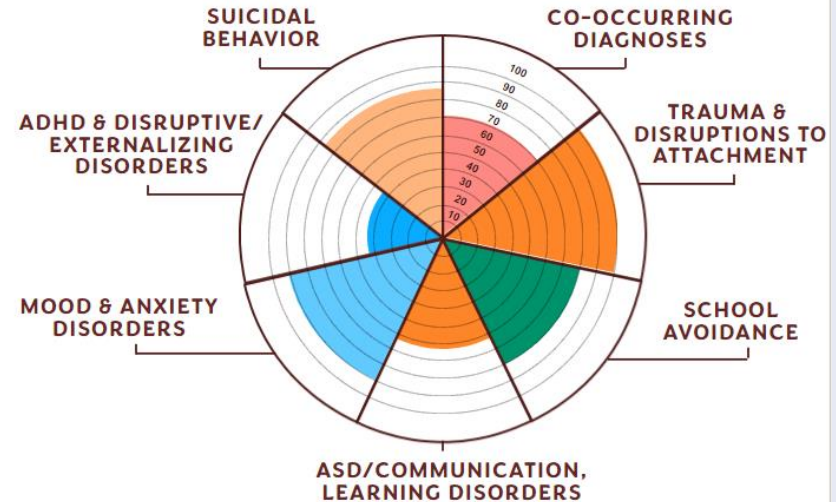
Home environment – adolescents learn to cope with everyday stressors in real time.

Recruitment – we overcome workforce challenges by recruiting excellent providers across the country and matching them with areas of need.



Our goal is to provide adolescents with a different experience of themselves and others

- We emphasize the importance of consistent staffing, daily routine, structure and communication
- We model healthy relationships in our interdisciplinary, non-hierarchical team
- Our approach is attachment-based, psychodynamic, solutions-focused, and cognitive-behavioral
- The most common diagnoses in the program are depression, anxiety, suicidal behavior, self-harm and trauma

Partial Hospitalization Program

PATIENTS

- Up to 12 patients in each group
- Ages 13-18
- Average 24 day length of stay
- 5 days a week
- 6 hours each day
- 8am – 2:30pm

CARE TEAM

- Psychiatrist
- Psychologist
- Therapists
- Nurse
- Behavioral Health Specialists

PROGRAM

- Milieu activities
- Individual therapy
- Group therapy
- Family therapy
- Tutoring support
- Healing arts programming
- Morning and afternoon check-ins and goal setting



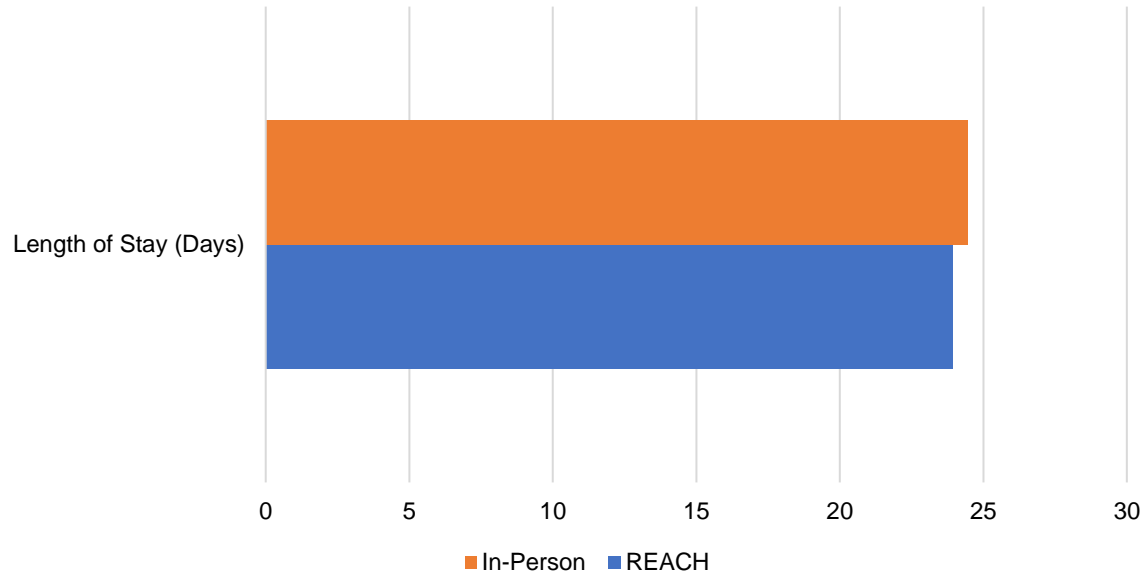
We partner with other agencies to ensure that gains in the program are sustained

- We work closely with schools, outpatient providers, pediatricians, child welfare and juvenile justice systems
- In Florida, we have successfully treated adopted and fostered teens, and have coordinated and treated teens living in residential facilities
- Our family-focused model works on helping the whole family function better
- Virtual care keeps teens in their communities while receiving treatment





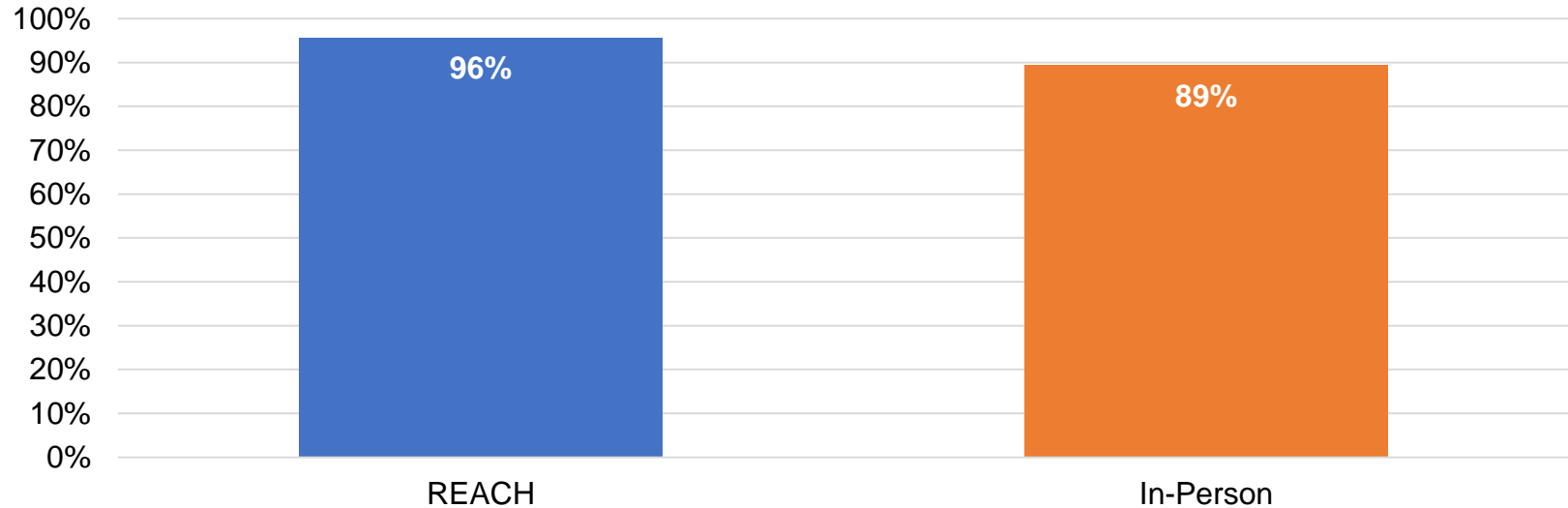
Length of stay in the Bradley REACH virtual partial compares favorably to our in-person program:



(Sample size: N = 456 for APHP and N = 214 for REACH)

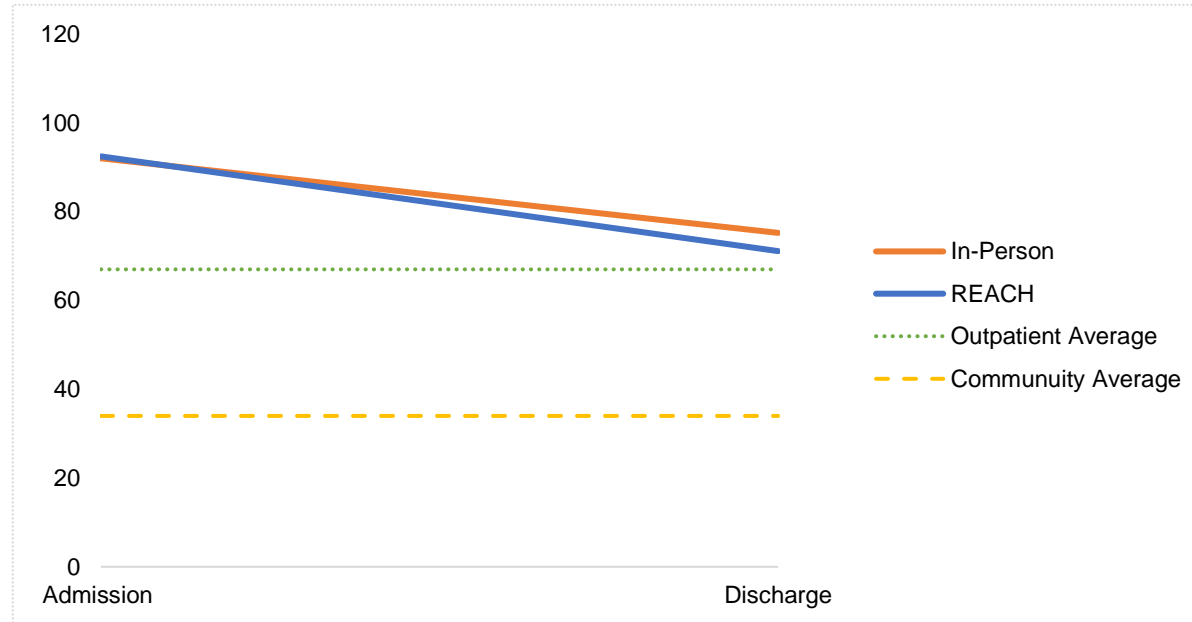


Virtual programs have consistently higher attendance than in-person programming:





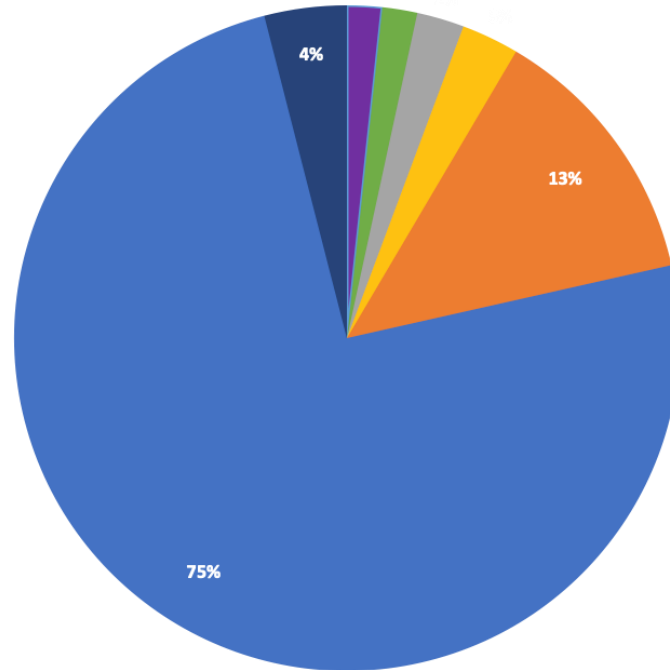
Youth Outcomes Questionnaire data suggests similar levels of acuity at admission and improvement at discharge (compared to our in-person program):





The majority of patients discharge to outpatient care:

● ED ● Inpatient ● Partial Hospitalization ● Intensive Outpatient ● Home-based ● Outpatient ● Other





Qualitative feedback from adolescents and families is consistently positive:

"It was very detailed and did a great job of keeping my son connected and engaged"

"My kid connected with his individual therapist, and our family therapist was able to advocate with the school and give me feedback on what was best"

"My teen gained good social and emotional skills"

"The staff made us feel comfortable and talked to us like people and didn't talk down to us"
