#### **INITIAL REQUEST & ASSUMPTIONS**

#### Business Statement

DCF is requesting that the current Master Client Index (MCI) interface be modified to prevent SSNs in the Client table from being updated to all zeroes. DCF further request that any existing values currently in the FASAMS database in the ClientModule.Client table be reverted back to its original submitted value stored in the ProviderClient.Identifier table.

#### Scope Definition

FEI will update MCI Interface to prevent SSNs in the Client table from being updated to all zeroes. All SSN values that are equal to all zeroes in the Client table will be updated to their originally submitted value stored in the ProviderClient Identifier table.

#### Assumptions, Constraints, Dependencies

• This correction to MCI Inteface will require redeployment



#### **EXISTING FUNCTIONALITY**

Currently, through the MCI Interface, Social Security Numbers having a value of all zeroes (000000000) are being inserted into Client table in the FASAMS database.

#### PROPOSED FUNCTIONALITY

Social Security Numbers with values of all zeroes will <u>not</u> be inserted into the Client table via the MCI Interface. Current SSNs with a value of all zeroes in the Client table will be updated to reflect the SSN stored on the ProviderClient.Identifier table.
