Review and Approval of April 9, 2025 Meeting Minutes

A motion was entered to approve the April 9, 2025 minutes. The motion was carried. The minutes were approved with no opposition.

Commission Update

Commission Chair Jay Reeve provided legislative updates on Senate Bill 1620 and House Bill 1439, which were consolidated into one bill, and the bill awaits the Governor's signature. This is a significant milestone, representing increased adoption of the Commission's formal recommendations. This year's in-person commission meeting will be held on September 2, 2025 at the JW Marriot in Orlando, 4040 Central Florida Parkway. The meeting will coincide with the 2025 Florida Children and Families Summit.

Legislative Bill Update – SB 168

Dr. Heather Flynn discussed Senate Bill 168. Section nine of the bill provides for the establishment of the Mental Health and Substance Abuse Data Repository. The Act will take effect on October 1, 2025. By December 1, 2025, the Northwest Regional Data Center will develop and submit an implementation plan and a plan for ongoing operation to the Governor, Senate President and Speaker of the House. During the first year the focus will be on securing permissions, data cleaning and harmonization.

Some of the agencies that will be submitting data include the Agency for Healthcare Administration (AHCA), the Department of Children and Families (DCF), the Department of Health (DOH), the Department of Juvenile Justice, the department of Corrections (DOC), the Agency for persons with Disabilities (APD). Invitations for agency representation should be sent to the Secretary or agency head after July 1, 2025 on Commission letterhead.
