

Dual Diagnosis Treatment Subcommittee – Program Examples

Recommendation 3: Replicate successful community integrated health teams to address the dual diagnosis needs of seniors with mental health disabilities or others with complex co-morbidities. (add examples)

- STREET Medicine (Pinellas)
- Palm Beach Co Fire Rescue has a program that follows up with individual on OD and MH calls. I do not think they provide Medical Care.
- Manatee County Rural Health -Mobile Community Health Clinic
- Primary Care/Behavioral Health Integration Program-BayCare Pinellas/Pasco Counties; Pinellas County Health Program (PCHP) with Directions for Living located in County Health Departments.
- DART - Drug Abuse Response Team, Volusia County, Daytona Beach Fire Department is the lead with paramedicine and we provide the counselors and peers for our MAT bridge. We also participate in a similar program in Marion County where we work with Ocala Fire Rescue and Marion Fire Rescue to provide the counselors and peers for a MAT bridge. In Marion, the program goes by the funding source name, CORE.
- Broward Health Point has a mobile unit that makes stops at both of BARC's residential locations.
- CCFR Paramedicine and Clay Behavioral Health Center - Clay
- Polk County community paramedics- employed by Polk County Fire Rescue

Recommendation 5: Continue to increase availability of short-term residential (non-crisis stabilization unit) treatment programs for youth. (add examples)

- The Grove (IMPOWER): The Grove has supported adolescents suffering from alcohol or substance abuse and in need of a more intensive individual support plan. Our voluntary residential program is available for youth 13-17 years old and involves a recommended 90 day stay (Substance Use primary)
