Definitions

- Recurrence/Arrest – violence against their partner that may have culminated in an arrest.
- Nonparticipation - excess absences.
- Noncompliance — failure to follow program rules.
- Drug/Alcohol Use - attending group while intoxicated; failure to attend court-ordered treatment (if applicable); or positive drug/alcohol screening (if applicable).
- Other — discharge for other reasons, i.e., relocation, transfer to another program, charges/injunction dropped, etc.
- Unknown – survey question was not completed.
