### 4. Deployment schedule for SAMHIS

Deployment of change requests will be implemented on a quarterly schedule.

#### 4.1. October 2017 deployment

October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017 deployment included the following change requests.

Number	Change Request Description	Notes
CR-012	Some covered services are not calculating units properly.	Correction of covered service unit calculations for ADMDW only. These changes are needed for the services that changed from ½ or 1 day to 240 or 480 minutes last year.
CR-001	MH PERF record to add new field "Discharge reason".	DREASON field added to the end of the PERF record. Please refer to the DCF

CR-006	EVNT records in ADMDW do not contain the billed and paid information carried forward from SAMH. SERV records in ADMDW do have the billed and paid carried over. EVNT billed and paid fields need updated in ADMDW as well.	EVNT records in ADMDW will be populated with billed and paid information.
CR-008	Modify SAMHIS DC file upload process to read the HOSPTIME days from the new 4-digit file format.	HOSPTIME (How many days has the person been in a hospital for mental health reasons?) field on the DC file upload expanding to 4 digits from 2. <b>This change request has been postponed to the January 2018 release.</b>
CR-007	TXBEGIN and TXEND neither were made part of the SQL load when billed and paid were added for SERV. Add them.	SERV records in ADMDW will be populated with treatment begin (TXBEGIN) and end (TXEND) information.

### 4.2. January 2018 deployment

CR-008	Modify SAMHIS Department of Corrections file upload process to read the days spent by incarcerated person in the hospital for mental health reason (HOSPTIME field) from 2 digits to the new 4-digit file format.	HOSPTIME (How many days has the person been in a hospital for mental health reasons?) field on the DC file upload expanding to 4 digits from 2.
CR-013	Correct Managing Entities access to Non-Client specific service Event data set (EVNT) on the Alcohol, Drug and Mental health Data Warehouse (ADMDW).	
CR-014	Change SAMHIS drug codes to match Department of Corrections Drug Codes.	
CR-015	Correct an issue with the Detox admission record that prevents a substance abuse discharge.	This fix will allow discharge to occur at any point after an admission despite the detox record.
