1. Provider Readiness for Version 14

The group will review the last Provider Readiness Report and discuss the work being completed to ensure providers are ready to submit data in Version 14 format by July 1, 2021.

Sharyn started by saying she talked with Wendy Scott regarding the MEMO and asked for an update. Rich assured this is being worked on but its currently with the Assistant Secretary, who is swamped, for review. Rich hopes the MEMO will come out within the next couple weeks.

2. FASAMS "Unexpected Error"

FEI will provide an update on the work in progress to address this issue.

Jesse updated saying they have contacted someone with AWS to identify where the issues are happening. He advised another AWS server has been setup that is a replica of production where they will start submitting bulk data to try and replicate the error in a controlled environment. Rich asked how to get through it for the time being. Jesse suggested resubmitting when you see the error and it'll process. Rich added reproducing the error is the big goal to fix the problem. Johnny asked as they start to upload the historical data should they email to say it's happening? Jesse said yes to send an email so they can monitor.

3. Quarterly Functional Review Briefing *NEW*

As a recent improvement to our quarterly release management process, FEI will provide a briefing to FASAMS stakeholders that outlines changes and improvements that will be included in the next release. The first of these briefing will take place during the DAC on 7/6/2021 and will outline the changes that will be placed int production on 8/1/2021.

Jesse stated Nathan wanted to have a new process and one step is for everyone that uses FASAMS to know the new enhancements being deployed in the next month. Essentially, with each quarter. The month following that quarter's end, there will be a functional review meeting that explains all the changes coming in the subsequent month.

4. Request from Larry Brown Regarding Service Event Rule *NEW*

Version 14 Chapter 6, item #3 of section 3.1.3 states "A client-specific service event for a covered service with a unit of measure of "Hours" must be the only client-specific service event for that service date and start time for that individual at that entire provider, regardless of admission."

"Are there edits in place that are currently turned off? Or are edits planned to be inserted? If not, when will the statement be removed from Pamphlet 155-2? Editing/rejecting SERVICES data on these criteria will cause significant operational difficulty throughout the state for providers trying to spend allocations which step outside the concept of bundled services."

Rich asked if there are any edits that enforce this. Jesse said he'd have to go back and check to see what the validation rule is regarding "Hours" specific service events. He said he'd provide an answer by the next DAC call. Rich posed a question to the group – he's in agreement with this should not being the limiting factor for services on a particular data but he is in agreeance with the start time.

3 Open Issues



Diego said the problem with this is you have team-based services where you have case managers who can be providing services on behalf of a client while they are also meeting with a therapist. Unless we're eliminating all team-based services reporting you will run into overlaps. Rich said that makes perfect sense and he's in full agreement. Rich asked Greg for these changes to be made in the pamphlet – take it out altogether (3.1.3 and 3.1.2 to be removed).
