1	Joseph asked Jesse if there was a way to delete out the subcontract data set? Je answered you'd be able to do so through the delete mechanism. Joseph then said he was just wondering of it could be purged. Jesse said that has been routed through the SAMH approval process, but he is still pending a response. Greg asked for the ticket number so that he could check on it. Joseph said he was ultimately just wondering if it was possible.
2	Beau stated when they were submitting data to five points for testing its stating that a diagnosis can does not appear in the list more than once - but what happens if someone comes in and the same diagnoses is used again as active once ended. Greg stated this is a good question as this is a clinical reality. He thinks the problem may be that when this was programmed it was expected that a diagnosis would change; however, he believes there's some capability within FASAMS where you can reflect changes in diagnosis between treatment episodes.
