CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

A. The Defendant is found not guilty of the offense or found not in violation of probation or community control for the cause of insanity, due to mental illness as defined in s. 916.106(13), Fla. Stat.

B. The Defendant currently meets the criteria for involuntary commitment to the Department of Children and Families as provided in s. 916.15, Fla. Stat., and in Rule 3.218, Fla. R. Crim. P., in that the Defendant, because of mental illness, is manifestly dangerous to himself or herself or others.

Based upon the FINDINGS OF FACTS and CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

- 1. The Defendant is not guilty by reason of insanity.
- 2. The Defendant is hereby committed to the Department of Children and Families to be placed in a mental health treatment facility.
- 3. The Defendant meets the criteria for commitment to a treatment facility of the Department of Children and Families as provided in s. 916.15(2), Fla. Stat.
- 4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to forthwith forward a certified copy of this Order along with copies of any written reports submitted to this Court by experts appointed by the Court relating to the issues of mental illness, manifest dangerousness and commitment; copies of any other psychiatric, psychological or

social work reports submitted to the court relative to the mental state of the Defendant; and a copy of the charging instrument and all supporting affidavits or other documents used in the determination of probable cause to the following email address:

Upon notification of an admission date by the Department of Children and Families, the Sheriff of ______ County shall, on the date specified, forthwith transport and deliver the Defendant to a treatment facility designated by the Department, together with a certified copy of this Order and the other documentation outlined in paragraph 4. above.
- 6. The Department, through the Administrator of the facility to which the Defendant is admitted, shall report directly to this Court, with copies to the attorneys for the State and the Defense on the issue of the need for continued commitment as provided in Rule 3.218, Fla. R. Crim. P., and s. 916.15(3), Fla. Stat.
- 7. In the event the Defendant's presence is required at any hearings in this cause, this Court shall issue an Order to Transport, directing the Sheriff of

County, or his designee to resume custody of and transport the
Defendant back to the jurisdiction of this Court.
8. This Court retains jurisdiction in this cause, pursuant to s. 916.16, Fla.
Stat., and the Defendant shall not be discharged or released from commitment
within the Department of Children and Families without further Order of this
Court.
